BYLAW 1.2021

A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN ROAD AS PRIMARY WEIGHT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosthern No. 403 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

PART I – PURPOSE & DEFINITIONS

Purpose

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to designate a certain road located in the Rural Municipality of Rosthern No. 403 as Primary Weight.

DEFINITIONS

- 2. Except as hereinafter provided, words used in this Bylaw shall have the meanings ascribed to them in *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations*, 2010.
- 3. In this Bylaw:
 - a) **Administrator:** means the Administrator of the Municipality; appointed pursuant to Section 2 of *The Municipalities Act*.
 - b) Municipality: means the Rural Municipality of Rosthern No. 403
 - c) **Minister:** means the member of the Executive Council to whom for the time being the Administrator of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997,* is assigned.

PART II – VEHICLE WEIGHTS / PROVISIONS

4. Any person may, without a permit issued operate or move or cause to be operated or moved on or over the Municipal Road as described as Portion of the road North of the North East Section Five (5) Township Forty-one (41) Range Three (3) West of the Third Meridian, North and West of the North West Section Five (5) Township Forty-one (41) Range Three (3) West of the Third Meridian as shown on the map in <u>Schedule A</u> to this Bylaw. A vehicle, the gross weight of which may be equal to, or less than, the limits specified for Primary Weights under Sections 13-15, inclusive, of *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations*, 2010 of the Highways and Transportation Act, 1997.

PART III – ENFORCEMENT

PENALTY

5. A person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence, no person shall exceed the maximum weight on the designated road as described in this bylaw unless given permitted approval from the Municipality.
